

SDAA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

FEB 14, 2026

SDAA Board of Directors met for their annual meeting in Yankton on Feb 14, 2026. Present were: President Jack Moulton, NFAA Director Tim Withers, NE Governor Leroy Capp, SW Governor Wade McClanahan, SE Governor Jeremy Zeeb and Sec/Treas Kathy Faber. Absent NW Governor Larry Johnson, and Bowhunter Director Tyler Pierce. Also present : Midwest Councilman Shorty Faber. Bruce Cull joined the meeting close to the end of the meeting.

Motion by McClanahan, second by Withers, to approve the minutes from the 2025 meeting. Carried
Motion by Withers, second by Capp to approve the Treasurer's report. Carried.

Old business: A discussion about the website ensued. Lalit Jain as built a new website for us and will be migrating over to our domain shortly.

The GFP commission meetings we sponsored were well received and Withers moved, Capp seconded to continue funding with a max of \$1500. Carried Monies will used from the Bowhunter fund to promote archery.

New Business: 4H shooting sports state meet in Pierre was discussed. SDAA members will be assisting similar to last year.

McClanahan suggested we have flyers made for our state shoots to sent to archery shops and clubs for posting.

Posting on the SDAA Facebook must be approved and guidelines have been set. Businesses may use it as a pathway to promote their SDAA affiliated business.

The 2027 Indoor State was discussed at length as to host and date.

Withers explained the new modern field round that will be implemented as a test at this year's outdoor sectionals. The state outdoor format was discussed.

A "grow the line" program was discussed. Bring a new person to our State tourney and get your entry fee discounted by half and the new person is free. Motion by Zeeb, second by Withers to implement this for all our events. Carried. logistics will be worked out.

SDAA bylaws and policy will be updated. Kathy will work with Erika at the NFAA to get this accomplished and get an idea for cost.

The State 600 round was discussed with a possibility of a split venue , Yankton and Rapid City. More info to follow.
